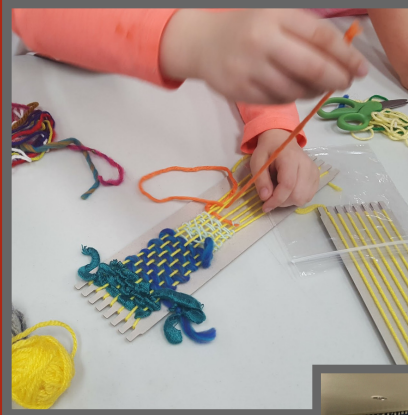
## Weaving for Beginners
